Every

- If the item does not fit in the bag, attach a sticker indicating combustibles for collection and place it at the designated pickup point.

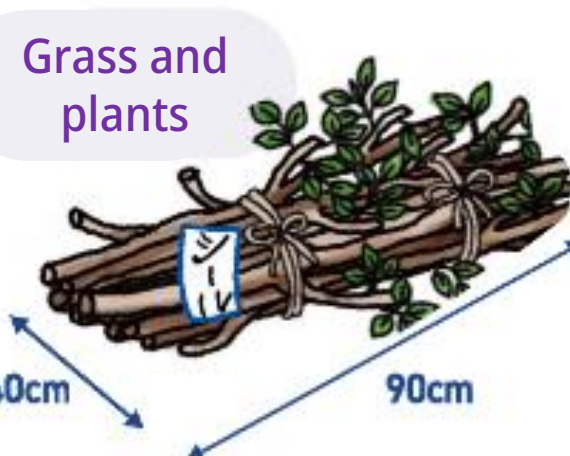


Designated bag for combustibles

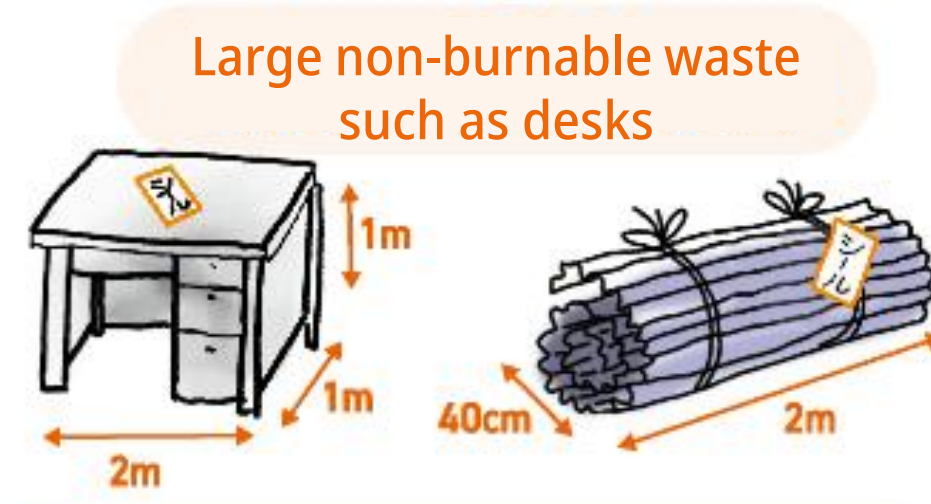

Recyclable Home Appliances

No designated bags or collection stickers are needed

Place in the green collection box

- Home appliances are also collected for recycling in addition to being disposed of as non-burnable waste
- Collection locations include Yonago City Clean Center, Yonago City Hall Main Building, 2nd Building, Yodoe Branch, and community centers (excluding Yamato and Utagawa).

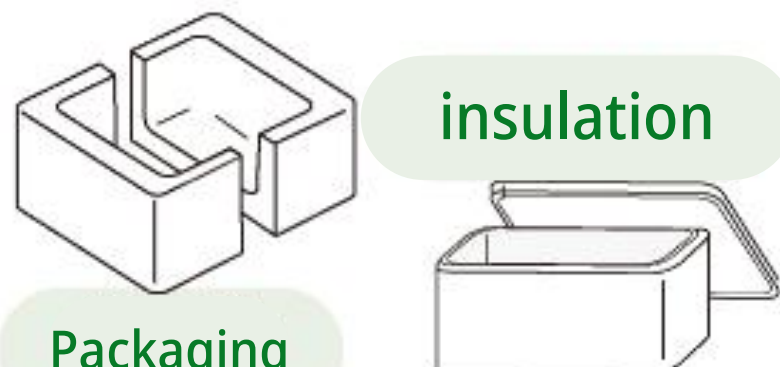

Place in a transparent or semi-transparent bag for collection

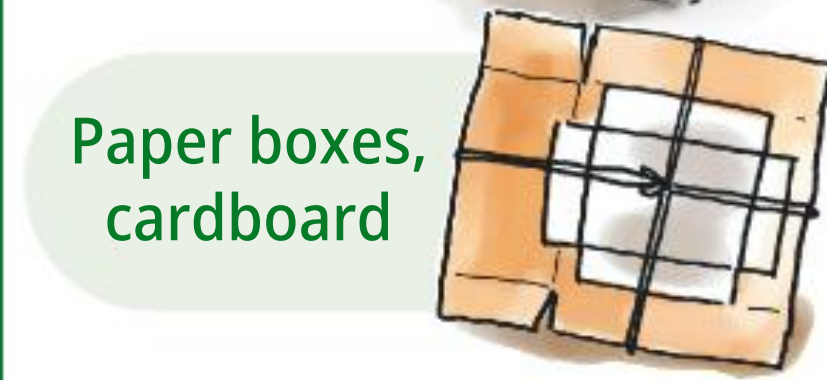
Old Paper
